Your letter of the 6th June, 1945 is acknowledged and you are advised that Building Restrictions are very stringent and permits are only issued in urgent necessitous cases, such as a man, his wife and family being without accommodation or living in overcrowded and unhealthy conditions. Careful re-consideration has been given to your application, but permission to build cannot be granted at the present time.
