

In reply to your letter of 26th July regarding refusal of your application for permission to erect a dwelling at Toronto, you are advised that due to the stringency of the existing building restrictions permits are only issued as a general rule, where it is necessary to house man, wife and children who are without accommodation (rented or otherwise) and until there is some easing of these restrictions your application must be refused.
