Dear Mr. James,

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of
3rd January '45, making representations on behalf of Mr. A.C.
Boddy of 42 Dreadnought Street, Lakemba, who desires permis-
sion to build a home at Fennell's Bay, Toronto.

Mr. Boddy has made several applications in
this connection, and has had personal interviews with the
Officers of this Department, and has on each occasion been
refused a permit.

Representations to the Minister have also
been made by D. Watkins Esq. on Mr. Boddy's behalf.

Mr. Boddy is the owner of a cottage at
Adamstown and another at Hamilton, and previously resided in
his cottage at Beaumont street, Hamilton, and was apparently
comfortably housed there. Mr. Boddy is at present staying
with his daughter at Lakemba accompanied by his wife.

As the applicant has from time to time
had and still has accommodation, and the present position in
regard to building resources being still acute, it is regretted
that a permit cannot be granted to Mr. Boddy at present.
