RE PERMISSION TO BUILD. EST. COST £324

Your letter of the 30th April, 1945 is acknowledged and you are advised that Building Restrictions are very stringent and permits are only issued in urgent necessitous cases, such as a man, his wife and family being without accommodation or living in overcrowded and unhealthy conditions. Careful re-consideration has been given to your application, but permission to build cannot be granted at the present time and it is suggested that you apply again in six months time when Building Restrictions may have eased.
